Mt. Greylock State Reservation lies in Berkshire County in the northwestern corner of Massachusetts. It is the highest point in the Commonwealth at 3,491 feet elevation. Acquired by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in 1898, it is one of our oldest state parks. Four hundred acres at the top of the mountain were donated to the State
